

Beware of Hotel and Attendee-list Scams

What you need to know to stay safe

It has come to our attention that scammers are targeting our meeting attendees and exhibitors, attempting to sell attendee lists and solicit bookings at unauthorized hotels. NHTSA does not rent or sell email lists to third parties. See the [NHTSA Privacy Policy](#) to learn more.

- Please be aware of any message coming from sources not affiliated with NHTSA. Avoid interaction with them.
- Valid emails come from @nationalhomelandsecurity.org and @asmii.net

Attendee List Email Scam

Unfortunately, emails are circulating that offer to sell attendee lists for the NHTSA Annual Conference. These emails are sent by scammers impersonating NHTSA.

- Note that NHTSA does not sell its exhibitor or attendee lists, and no third party is authorized to distribute or sell any lists related to our events.
- Statements claiming to offer our attendee lists are fraudulent.

If you receive emails that propose to sell NHTSA conference attendee lists, do not engage with the sender and delete the message immediately.

Hotel Booking Scam

Our conferences are also the target of hotel scams. Scammers call or email attendees and exhibitors, claiming to represent NHTSA or NHTSA vendors, and encourage our customers to book rooms using fake promotion codes at various hotels close to the conference venue(s).

Please know that NHTSA and the venue or convention center will NOT be calling anyone to make a room reservation and that any person who claims to do so on our behalf is not authorized to do so.

If ANYONE contacts you about booking housing or purchasing attendee/data lists, please be advised that they are poachers who are not authorized by NHTSA and should be reported to NHTSA HQ and ignored.

Checking Email Header

If you think the email is suspicious, you can check the email header to make sure it's from NHSA. Here are some instructions on how to do that: <https://www.wikihow.com/Read-Email-Headers>

- REMEMBER: NHSA does not rent or sell your email address to third parties.
- REMEMBER: Do not click on any links that look suspicious.
